



Care Guide

Follow the guidelines below to ensure your piece of furniture gets the love and attention it deserves:

- As with all quality furniture, avoid rooms that may experience extreme temperature or humidity changes as this may cause excessive timber movement and cracking.
- Protect your furniture from strong or prolonged sunlight.
- Do not place your furniture near heat sources, radiators or air conditioning units.
- Uneven floors may give the impression that doors of wardrobes or sideboards are askew, which can be easily fixed by levelling the item with a small wedge.
- Wood is a natural product. The colours, markings and grain pattern can therefore vary from item to item. Please also be aware that timbers may experience movement and cracking throughout its lifetime.
- Where provided, please always follow the fitting instructions. Take care not to tighten any bolts too much.
- Use protection such as coasters or place mats to avoid spillages and marks, and only clean with a damp cloth.
